FOREWORD.

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Pamphlet No. 2 is issued by the Sub-Department of Forestry as a companion to Pamphlet No. 1, describing North Queensland Building Timbers, to complete the general specifications for timbers suitable for building over the whole of the State of Queensland.

As a result of the concentration of labour and materials on the war effort housing alone fell behind to the extent of more than 30,000 dwellings in this State, up to December, 1944, and the Queensland Government is now using every possible means to assist in the expansion of the building trade and the erection of urgently needed homes for the people.

This pamphlet, in showing how many of our lesser known woods can effectively be used in house building, can give considerable help in the present emergency.
